



## **\$750 BURSARY AVAILABLE FOR NOVA SCOTIA STUDENTS IN 3<sup>RD</sup> YEAR OF STUDY IN THE FOLLOWING PROGRAMS:**

Faculty of Forestry and Environmental Management; UNB  
Forest Ecosystem Management Program  
Forest Engineering Program (RPF option)

This annual award is intended to create awareness of, and future participation in, the various professional forestry associations in Canada, and more particularly in Nova Scotia.

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

The Registered Professional Foresters Association of Nova Scotia is pleased to make this award available to students from Nova Scotia who are in their 3<sup>rd</sup> year of study in one of the above programs.

### **CRITERIA:**

This bursary is intended to reward a deserving Nova Scotia student enrolled in one of the above programs. Factors that will be considered in making the award include:

1. participation in Forestry Faculty activities;
2. participation in university activities;
3. participation in high school activities;
4. academic competence and awards(if any);
5. participation in summer activity that prepares for future career;
6. participation in professional associations;
7. recommendations of faculty;
8. the overall impression of the students written application.

### **APPLICATION PROCESS:**

Eligible students will prepare a report / application, in electronic format, which describes their eligibility, their achievements and their participation relative to the above criteria. Completed reports/ applications, titled "**Application for RPFANS Bursary**" are to be submitted to-----  
(consult your faculty advisor for name of faculty member)-----in the Faculty of Forestry and Environmental Management, by December 1, annually.

### **SELECTION PROCESS:**

Faculty will review the students' report / application and provide a comment to RPFANS on the students' suitability for the bursary. Faculty will then submit the applications to the RPFANS Executive Director, including any comments, for the consideration and final selection by the RPFANS Council. It is anticipated that the award will be made in early January of each year.

### **NUMBER OF AWARDS:**

There will be up to one award made annually. However, the Association reserves the right to withhold the award in any year in which there are no applicants; or the applicants do not meet the expected standards for the award.
